**I. Approval of Board of Health Meeting Minutes**

Dr. Elisabeth DiPietro made a motion to approve the May 12<sup>th</sup>, May 19<sup>th</sup> and May 26<sup>th</sup> 2020 Board of Health Meeting Minutes. Dr. David Kominz second the motion. Vote unanimous. Motion carries.

**II. Planned Protest March June 3, 2020**

The Board had a brief discussion about the proposed march planned tomorrow morning. The BOH was informed by the President of the Chief of Police Association that it was not mandatory to enforce the masking of participants during protests, but to offer masks if individuals do not have one to wear. Resident John Hennessey believes the march should go peacefully. Public Health Director Wendy Diotalevi will be attending and available to hand out masks if someone should want one. Social distancing is encouraged and masks made available.

**III. Complaint – Brothers Marketplace**

Resident Pamela Foster came before the Board to voice a complaint that Brothers Marketplace did not have plastic barriers installed at the registers. Ms. Foster was informed that plastic barriers are not required, but CDC recommended. Brothers have a COVID-19 plan that requires their cashiers wear masks and face shields.

**IV. Director’s Report – COVID-19 Update**

The update on the COVID-19 situation in Weston is no new cases and the number remains at 106 positive cases. The total deaths in Weston is 26.

Public Health Director is working with the Town Manager to enforce the 25% occupancy order per the Governor for office space. All Town Hall employees have all been ordered back per Weston Administration which goes against the Governor’s order. Working to come into compliance for 25% occupancy meaning 1 person in the Board of Health office at a time and continue to telework when possible.
