I. **Approval of Board of Health Meeting Minutes – July 28, 2020 and August 11, 2020**

Dr. David Kominz made a motion to approve the July 28, 2020 and August 11, 2020 Board of Health Meeting Minutes. Laura Azzam second the motion. Vote unanimous. Motion carries.

II. **4:15pm: Hearing: 661 Boston Post Road Title 5 Variance Requests**

Michael Sullivan, R. S. of Sullivan, Connors & Associates came before the Board to request the following Variances from Title 5 *310 CMR 15.211(i)*: septic tank and leach field offset to a tributary to a water supply is less than 200ft. (125ft and 175ft proposed).

Mr. Sullivan informed the Board that the existing septic system has failed and needs to be replaced. The proposed upgraded septic system is designed to accommodate the existing 6 bedrooms and no garbage grinder is allowed. There is no increase in flow to the property.

Public Health Director Wendy Diotalevi requested the need for monolithic tanks to be installed as an additional measure of protection. Abutters were notified of this hearing. Mr. Sullivan will follow up with Cambridge Water Supply for their input and approval to move forward as well with this proposed design.

Dr. David Kominz made a motion to approve the above Title 5 Variance as requested with the revision that monolithic tanks be installed. Laura Azzam second the motion. Vote unanimous. Motion carries.

III. **Director's Report – COVID-19 Update**

Public Health Director Wendy Diotalevi informed the Board that she'll be looking to hire additional nurses to help with contact tracing when school starts up and the school nurses resume their duties and will no longer be able to help. Jamy Gaynor has been hired to fill the Director of Health Services for the Weston Public Schools for the upcoming school year. Ms. Diotalevi will reach out to connect with her and the schools.
